Notes: Claimant unemployment figures are seasonally adjusted for the second quarter of the year. This series relates only to claimants aged 18+, and is based on the current definition of claimant unemployment. All other figures are from the Labour Force Survey for the Spring of each year and include all those aged from 16 to retirement ages, and are not seasonally adjusted. The Labour Force definitions of unemployment and inactivity apply for 1979. Thereafter the ILO definition (based on a four week instead of a one week job search period) applies. All figures, other than claimant unemployed, have been substantially revised for the years from 1992.
