For years where figures are not available for help with homeowner housing costs, a trend-based estimate has been included in the total help with housing costs figures for Northern Ireland. From 1997/98 figures for help with mortgage costs include assistance given as part of the jobseeker's allowance scheme, as well as income support. From 2008/09 figures for homeowners include help under the income support, state pension credit, jobseeker's and employment and support allowance schemes.
