Notes: The reduction in grant to the Northern Ireland Housing Executive (NIHE) in 1989/90 follows some £366 million of NIHE debt being written off. This had a neutral impact on the NIHE programmes.

Budget provision for voluntary housing is net of capital receipts, and is adjusted to outturn.

NIHE net lending figures from 1997/98 onwards are negative, as receipts and debt repayments exceed planned new investment.

Figures for renovation grants etc include grants for housing adaptations but do not include provision for Warm Homes grants.

Figures for co-ownership are only available back to 2004/05; in previous years they are included in the voluntary housing figures.

Figures for total NIHE grant and net lending for 2015/16 onwards were not available at the time of publication.
